1889 at Lucknow, **Frederick James Appleby**, age 29 (GRO Army Death Indices)
1894 during cholera epidemic at Lucknow, **Private J C APPLEBY**, 1st Batt. East Lancs Reg.

MILITARY RECORDS

Thomas APPLEBEE, bookbinder of St Martins, Middx, attested 5 dec 1838 at London as Private in European Regt. Arrived 1839 on 'Thetis' (also on Medal Rolls)
James APPLEBY, grocer from Barnard Castle, Durham, attested at Liverpool on 27 jul 1857 as Private in 1st European Fusiliers – arrived 1857 Bombay on 'Gosforth' (also on Medal Rolls)
Edward APPLEBY, clerk from Walworth, Surrey, attested Liverpool 6 oct 1858 as Gunner 1 Batt Artillery. Arr 1858 on 'Caroline Coventry'
Edward APPLEBY, Bombadier, Madras Artillery, on Medal Rolls for 1842 China Campaign
Jonathan APPLEBY, Seaman, received an East India Company Pension of £4 16s for life in respect of injury or infirmity – record dated 6 aug 1818
