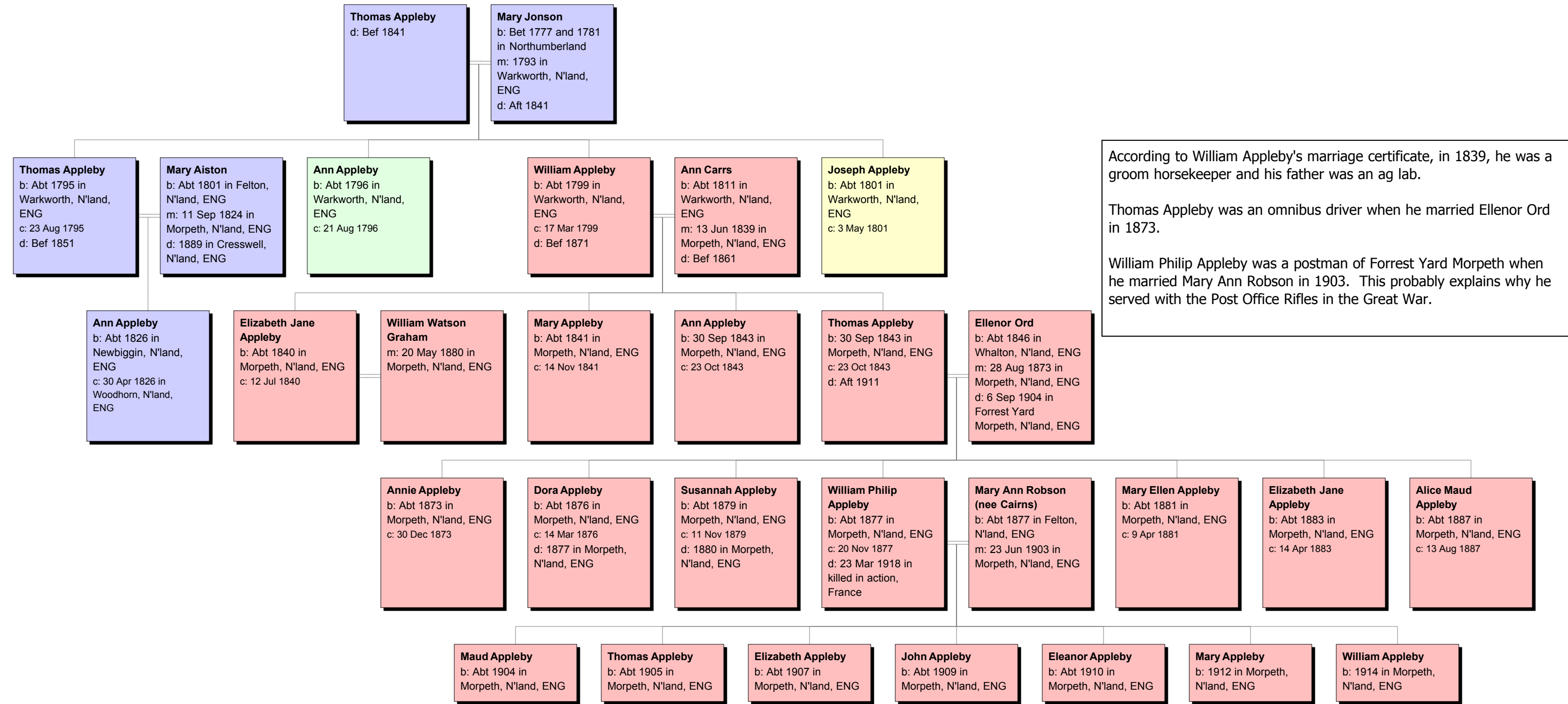


Descendants of Thomas Appleby



According to William Appleby's marriage certificate, in 1839, he was a groom horsekeeper and his father was an ag lab.

Thomas Appleby was an omnibus driver when he married Ellenor Ord in 1873.

William Philip Appleby was a postman of Forrest Yard Morpeth when he married Mary Ann Robson in 1903. This probably explains why he served with the Post Office Rifles in the Great War.
